Principal's Report: Annette Roraback

- There are plans to remodel the old offices to refresh the space and increase usable space
- On Monday, November 3rd, there was a small fire in one of the kindergarten bathrooms
 - No student or staff was harmed
 - o Efficiency of student and staff evacuation was commended
 - o Fire put out with small fire extinguisher
 - As of Thursday, November 6th, all students and staff were back in the kindergarten wing
- Early release day is Wednesday, November 12th
- Family Math Day and Literacy Café are replacing Special Persons Day:
 - o Family Math Day will be on Wednesday November 12th for all grades but 1st Grade
 - o There are brand new math standards so PCE wanted to give parents an opportunity to see what students are doing in class in regards to math
 - Literacy Café will be held in the Spring
 - o There will be STAAR training for parents in early Spring
- Growth in College Station:
 - o Steady 3% increase in CSISD student enrollment in the past; but now 6% growth
 - New schools planned:
 - Spring Creek Elementary opening in early fall
 - New intermediate school and elementary school opening within 5-6 years
 - New middle school opening in 6+ years
- There will be an upcoming bond election in early Spring
- PCE was a recipient of the Walmart Community Grant program Bryan Briarcrest Wal-Mart and the Wal-Mart Foundation gave a \$2500 grant, which will be used to purchase Redcat audio systems.
