- I. Call to Order:
 - a. Megan Jonasson called the meeting to order at 8:35am

I.Special Presentation - VATRE presentation – Mike Martindale

- 1. Voter Approved Tax ratification election (Prop A):
 - 1. School funding is set at 2.5% of appraised value...everything beyond 2.5% growth compresses tax rate down. Due to our growth, we can reduce tax rate 6.7 cents; however, instead of reducing the tax rate 6.7 cents, with voter approval, we could reduce it 3.7 cents, and leave remaining 3 cents on the tax rate, collect revenue, and apply it increasing teacher pay? CS is lagging behind other districts, this is a financially responsible way to increase pay.
 - 2. VATRE is last thing on the November ballot, scroll all the way down!
 - 3. Utilizes additional money on the tax rate to generate additional revenue
 - 4. Would equate to additional \$5 million in tax revenue
 - 5. 6% raise for teachers, 4% raise for administrators
 - 6. Early voting begins Monday, October 24
 - 7. Election Day, Tuesday November 8

 - This fund helps support book fair kids will be able to shop at Book Fair (gift card); also helps nurse if she has any last-minute needs; PHP Angel Tree (if any needs are left over, this will go towards those funds)
 - 2. About 200 kids on Free Lunch, so as numbers are creeping up; will need to use our money wisely to ensure that we can help as many kids as possible

- a. Approval of Minutes from September 2022 meeting
 - 1. Cheryl Robison made a motion to approve; Melissa Poling seconded the motion. The motion passes, minutes are approved.
- b. Citywide PTO Update
 - 1. Education foundation grant submission is closed. They will award grants on Nov. 16th.
 - 2. The education foundation is funding the buses for all 1st and 2nd graders in the district to attend OPAS Jr. at TAMU. It is \$14,000 for all the buses.
 - 3. 14,500 students in CSISD. Up 300 students from last year.
 - 4. 8 National Merit Semi National Finalist
 - 5. Food Drive February 13-17, 2023 Theme: "Caring for each other"
 - 6. Teacher Appreciation week will be April 3-6, 2023 (observed by parents and PTOs); schools will still observe the one in May
 - Proposition A that will be on the ballot in November under the school district section (not to be confused with other propositions that are also going to be on the ballot from the city, etc). f. Carnival Update

Communications: ****All program changes are due to Cheryl by next Tuesday morning, <u>Oct 11</u>. She sent out an updated map today; please check it over and send her a message letting her know of any changes or if your section looks okay.

Decorations: Most of the hallway decorations are completed. Every child decorated a leaf to be hung up.

Food: Still working on gift cards from grocery stores (to purchase water & drinks) and a possible donation from Pepsi (drinks to sell & 2 L bottles for soda toss game). Decided to

skip pizza this year. We will not require use of the refrigerator and lunch line area this year. We can use ice from the ice maker at school for coolers. Committee members will bring large coolers for 2 drink selling stands. Have Food Trucks coming to carnival. Profit share

Games: Games are being finalized. There are close to 45 games. Verify with Ms Zapalac & Ms Williams that we can use their rooms for games. We will not have a cast room or dunk booth this year.

Kids Raffle: Baskets need to be assembled & ready a week from tomorrow to display the week prior to carnival. Kids raffle will be set up on the stage in the cafeteria the week of October 17th - 21st. Kids are able to bring money to purchase tickets. They are .25 cents each. Every kid in the entire school will be given one ticket. Teachers will be able to use tickets as rewards for good behavior. Specifics are being worked out. Raffle drawing will happen after carnival closes. All winners will be contacted the week after carnival!
