- I. Call to Order
 - A. Adrienne Shields called the meeting to order at 12:01 PM.
- II. Welcome Guests
 - A. Adrienne Shields welcomed everyone back and asked guests to introduce themselves.
- III. Approval of Minutes from November 2018 Meeting
 - A. Cheryl Robison moved to approve the November 2018 Pebble Creek Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes. Lara Clark seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- IV. Treasurer's Report Jill Moore
 - A. Jill reported that we haven't had too much activity due to the break other than some Carnival activity and Candy Cane Fun Run.
 - B. She also reminded everyone about the vote in October to move excess funds to school betterment. The move leaves us with \$1,000 in cash reserves.

- V. Principal's Report Blaire Grande
 - A. Pardon our mess in the Enchanted Forest; we have a group working on a teacher leadership project to help provide a storage and easily accessible place for science materials. We are also trying to provide an equitable opportunity for our students to have large meeting spaces for science labs, large group activities, etc. similar to the pods and science labs newer schools have. This will be our meeting space for PTO meetings as we move forward. We added a new PPCD class Monday and needed to shift some people around to make that work. Room 202 was needed so we had to adjust.
 - B. I have requested many ballpark figures for different improvement projects at the school. The cafeteria is a space used by all children every single day, so it is where we are wanting to begin. Here are some items we are considering and getting quotes for: new curtains (current can't be cleaned or will deteriorate), sound boards to help absorb sound, and murals to brighten it up as well as paint.

We will be doing both of those things and still have lots left over for a school improvement project/need. As soon as we get some quotes and ideas on cost I will share with the family before making a final decision on how to use the monies. Once that is confirmed I will also share with the PTO. :)

- VI. New Business
 - A. Board Vote on Budget Item Adrienne Shields
 - Our garden committee has asked for funds to prep the bed that runs along the carpool lane. Candice will be providing labor at no cost; she would like money for soil, mulch and maybe a few shrubs. Cheryl Robison made a motion to move \$300 from school betterment to the Garden Committee. Staci Cocanougher seconded the motion and the motion passed.
 - B. 50 Men Who Can Cook Adrienne Shields
