9.000 POUNDS OF FOOD DONATED AT CANDY CANE FUN run!

The 2019 Candy Cane Fun Run was a great day for Pebble Creek Elementary and the Salvation Army of Bryan/ College Station! We had a fantastic day filled with lots of energetic students, siblings, and parents who came out to run and enjoy lots of fun together!

The December 6th CCFR brought in a total of 478 pounds of food and \$1,420 in cash donations. When the money was converted to pounds (\$1 equals 6 pounds of food), the grand total was 9,000 pounds of food! All donations benefited the Salvation Army of Bryan/College Station.



Second Grade brought in the most food and money at an equivalent of 2,517 lbs! They received an extra recess with a SNOWBALL FIGHT as their reward. Since the equivalent of 4 tons of food were collected, Mrs. Grande and Mr. Whileyman were wrapped in gift paper during morning assembly before winter break.
