Items most needed at the Food Bank include beans (canned or dried), canned meats (tuna, chicken, ham, etc.), boxes of cereal (all sizes), cereal bars, chili, coffee, canned fruits/vegetables, peanut butter, rice, ravioli, pasta and soups.

The morning of the Fun Run, students, parents and siblings run or walk the halls of the school while collecting candy canes! Cookies and hot chocolate will be served. Be sure to bring your camera and take some fun photos! More information will be going out in Monday folders soon!

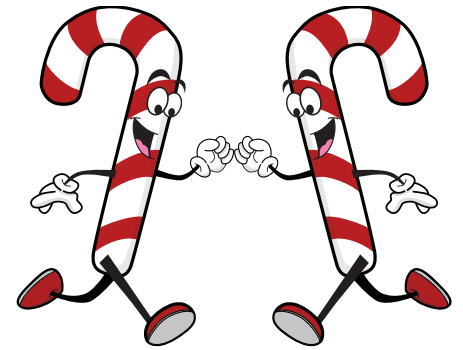
This year we have two fun contests going on. First, the grade that collects the most canned food (based on weight) will
