Fall is upon us and the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) is incredibly thankful for our Panther families, faculty, staff and administration. About a year ago, Pebble Creek Elementary (PCE) celebrated its 20th anniversary. During this time, the PTO has been hard at work funding the replacement of the broken cafeteria audio and visual system, 2nd Grade planters, broken art desks and outdated library books and furniture. This year, we are replacing broken teacher desks and the 3rd Grade planters as well as enhancing the safety of all of our Panthers by outfitting all of our teachers with walkie talkies.

Our PTO exists because of your generosity and involved and dedicated volunteers working side by side with our faculty to steadily improve our school. Over the past couple of years, we have conducted large-scale fall fundraiser fun runs with the help of third parties to help fund these school upgrades. This fall, we have decided to focus our attention on helping those affected by Hurricane Harvey by kicking off a small-scale, in-house fundraiser.

PCE is participating in a program called Principals Helping Principals whereby principals are matched with schools in Harvey-impacted areas. Our school has



been paired with Hitchcock ISD "Kids First" Head Start, which suffered much damage in the wake of Hurricane Harvey. They lost their cubbies, storage cabinets, books, educational play sets and more in the devastating floods.

With your help, we are giving to this school in need by kicking off a fall fundraiser on Monday, October 23rd called Panthers Race to the Rescue.
