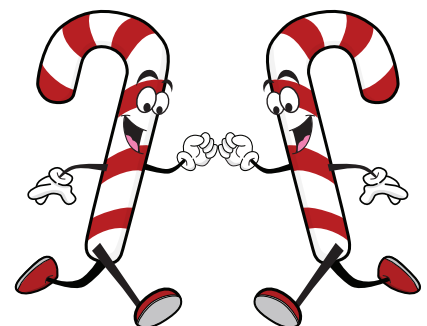

Wee Deliver is an internal mail system for students, teachers and parents as a way to send letters to others at Pebble Creek Elementary. It is a program that is designed to help improve reading and writing skills of elementary school children. Each year, Wee Deliver handles about 2,000 letters.

Letters will be delivered each Thursday morning to the classrooms and offices by 4th grade students chosen as Postmasters for the semester. The unique Wee Deliver stamps have been designed by current
