SEND LETTERS TO STUDENTS & STAFF WITH PEBBLE CREEK'S WEE DELIVER - NOW OPEN!

Wee Deliver is an internal mail system for students, teachers and parents to send letters to others at Pebble Creek Elementary. It is designed to help improve reading and writing skills of elementary school children and each year; Wee Deliver handles about 1,000 letters.

The unique Wee Deliver stamps are designed by current Pebble Creek students and are located on the Wee Deliver table by the front office along with stationary for everyone to use. Each month new stamp winners will be chosen and their stamps will be in use for that month. To find your child's home room address – look on the Wee Deliver table by the mailbox or online at www.pebblecreekpto.org Parents, we encourage you to write regular letters to your students throughout the year. They don't have to be long – a note saying good luck on a test, thinking about you or a simple "I love you" is a treasure to them. The kids just love getting letters and knowing they are thought of that day! We also hope you help your child send kind notes to their school friends. Please take a few minutes to teach them about how to address a letter and why each piece of information on the envelope is important.

We are excited to deliver your letters and love how this program both teaches and encourages our students!
